



## “C” CONTEST

### Who can enter “C” CONTEST?

C CONTEST is open to residents of Prince Edward County thirty (30) years of age and under. So if you're the right age and have an idea, this is your time!

### Guidelines

“C” CONTEST entries must present an original, personal perspective about your life in Prince Edward County. We're looking for entries that are entertaining and **original with a personal hook**. We want to hear your voice and perspective. Your entry can be sad, funny or witty, or any or all of those. It can be about someone or something that happened to you a short time ago or a long time ago, or something you heard about, or something you believe will happen tomorrow or ten years from now. It can be a story, an experience, or a feeling. It's your time to use your imagination and a time to shine and say what you think needs to be said about your life in the County! Tell us something no one else knows; tell us what you really think!

## **What are the categories of C CONTEST?**

You may enter any one of these categories:

- **Work on paper** or canvas by an individual (Text, painting, photos)
- **Work in three-dimensions** by an individual (sculptures)
- **Live Performance by an individual**
- **Live Performance by a group** of peers or by an intergenerational group
- **Multimedia by an individual** (Documentary, animation...)
- **Multimedia by a group** of peers or by an intergenerational group (Documentation, animation...)
- **Web site** (individual or by a group)

## **What are the age categories of “C” CONTEST?**

- 12 years old and under
- 13-18 years old
- 19-30 years old

## **What media can I use in my entry?**

“C” CONTEST is open to all forms of media including but not limited to movies, audio, paint, print, sculpture, text, song, dance, poetry, theatre, performance skit, and website. The maximum duration for movies is five minutes.

## **Why is “C” CONTEST exciting?**

“C” CONTEST is an exciting way to talk about people, issues, ideas and events that interest you. Tell us something we don’t know about your ancestry, about hockey or a skateboard, about the place you live, or about how you love your calf or dog. It can be about something you really like a lot, or about something you really don’t like a lot. Why not tell us about something that makes you laugh out loud. You can use any media form to express your idea. Your challenge is to create something original out of that experience. Why? For the fun of it AND because there are cash prizes. Sound too good to be true?

## **Cash prizes**

That’s right, there are cash prizes in all categories. And like other contests, you have to enter to have a chance. And you have to have your Entry Form in by the end of February 2010. Mark it on your calendar. Winners will be announced at the “C” Awards Gala in the spring of 2010.
